What is Kinwell?

Where are Kinwell clinics located and when will they open?

The first Kinwell clinics will open in Wenatchee and Yakima in December of 2021. Early in 2022, clinics will open in Lynnwood, Mill Creek, Renton, Pasco, and Seattle's South Lake Union neighborhood. By the end of 2022, clinics will open in Bellingham, Poulsbo, Richland, and other locations around Washington state.

What services will Kinwell clinics offer?

Our healthcare teams will treat everyday issues like sprained ankles and belly aches. We'll also manage chronic illnesses like high blood pressure, depression, and diabetes. More than that, Kinwell teams will listen to patients and help them reach their individual goals for vital, healthy living.
